Our client is one of the major Universities in the country. The requirement was to carefully digitise thesis books that could not be guillotined.

The books were scanned on specialized flatbed book scanners, while special care was taken while handling the books to not damage them any further. All images then underwent an Optical Recognition process to convert all computer generated text into searchable format.

The scanned images were then indexed based on title and author. ADEC completed the project in record time and no damage occurred on these rare books.
